FNE Options by School

Ford, Green Valley, McGlone, Oakland:

1. Turnaround
2. Replacement by DCIS or SOAR

Noel (not mutually exclusive):

1. Convert to Turnaround
2. Change Program: i.e. become Arts Program
3. Change Grade Structure to 6-12
4. Right-size Noel Program/Co-locate KIPP (5-8)

Montbello (not mutually exclusive):

1. Convert to Turnaround
2. Add Additional Programs (i.e. Career Technical Education)
3. Right-size Montbello Program/Co-locate DCIS (6-12)
