- **NO** schools will be closed.
- **NO** students will be displaced or excluded.
- **Improved offerings and increased options:** five new options for middle school, six new options for high school
- **All elementary schools included in the proposal will remain neighborhood schools**
- **Relieve school overcrowding:** adding 2,400 seats over the next five years
- **Improved access to services** for English Language Learners and Special Education Students in all FNE schools
- **Improved Transportation System** with shuttle system for all schools
- **Enrollment Zone** for middle school (entering 6th graders) and high school (entering 9th graders) provides equal access for FNE students to all FNE schools
- **Improved athletics program** which maintains existing traditions and provides opportunities for more students to participate
